The story of the Shrine of Our Lady at Walsingham begins in Saxon times. In 1061, the Lady of the Manor, Richeldis de Faverches, was taken in spirit to Nazareth, shown the house where the Annunciation took place and asked by the Blessed Virgin to build a replica in Norfolk. She was promised "*Whoever seeks my help in this place will not go away empty-handed.*"
