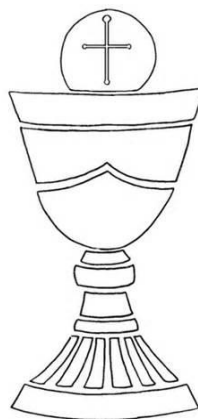
November Mass Envelopes - are available for your convenience on the Paper-Table in the Narthex.
